3. Review of Performance for Recovery Act Phase

1 and 2 Providers and Approval of Funding Modifications

The Planning/Oversight Committee reviewed and approved this item. Quarterly data was reviewed and almost all program operators are 50% enrolled.

The recommendation of the Planning/Oversight Committee to the SETA Governing Board is to deobligate the following program operators:

- 1. TechSkills of Sacramento: \$80,760
- 2. Tree of Hope Funding: \$32,500
- 3. Mutual Assistance Network: \$29,907

In addition, reallocate funds to the following providers that exceeded 50% enrollment: La Familia, Asian Resources, and Bach Viet.

There are additional TANF wage subsidy funds available to augment those providers. Staff is recommends allocating \$350,000 to three providers and come back in March to see how the other operators are doing to reallocate the rest of the funds.

If this is approved, it will go to the SETA Governing Board for review and approval at their February 4 meeting.
